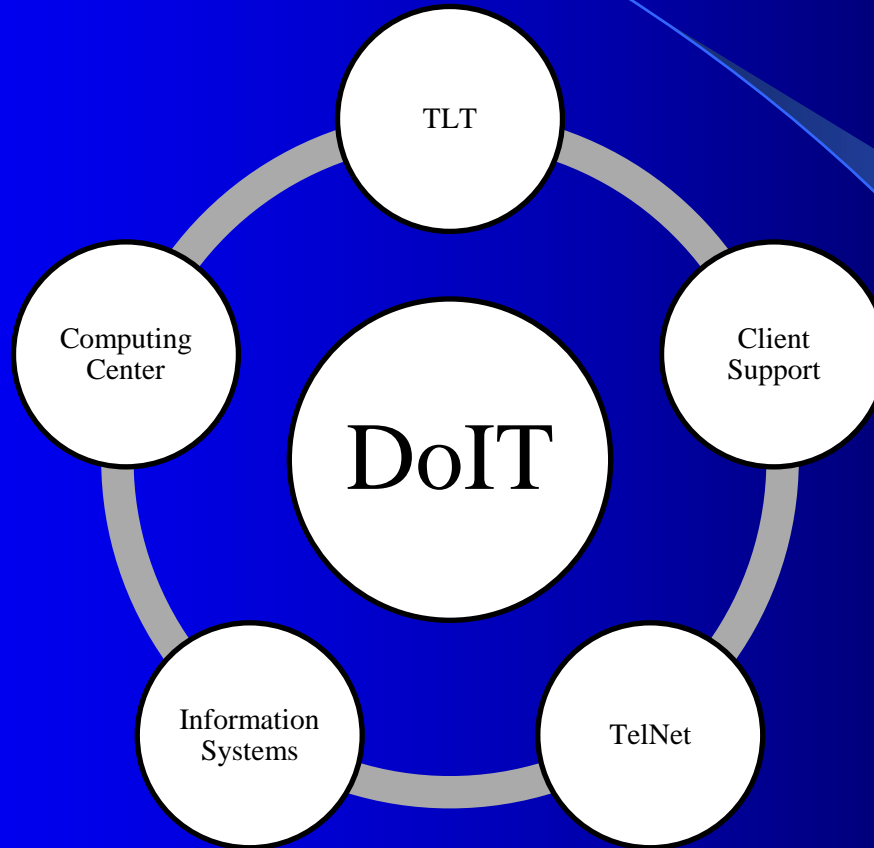

Student OnLine Accounts and Records

- Registration for courses
- Grades
- Employment opportunities
- Contact information – preferred e-mail, phone
- How to connect

- From SB home page select Solar in left menu

- Solar ID == Stony Brook ID number

- Initial password – birthdate– MMDDYY

Login – change password – Save

Logout – Log back in with new password.

Net ID is Key

- Login to public computers for Internet, Printing, MySBMail, MySBFiles, and My Site (SharePoint)
- Blackboard
- Print from Anywhere!
- Resnet and campus jacks - Must pass CAT to connect.
- Wireless (WolfieNet & AirNet not GuestNet)
- Dial-up
- Library databases from off campus

- Set your Net ID in SOLAR
- Choose your security question wisely!

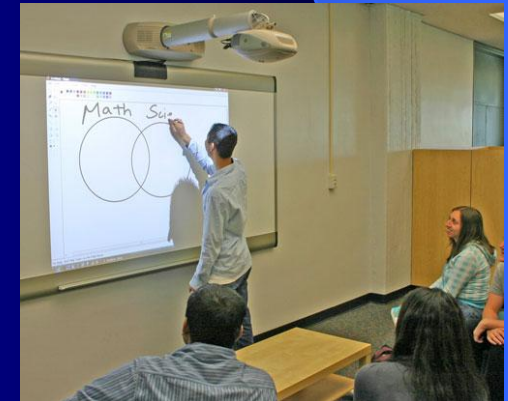
