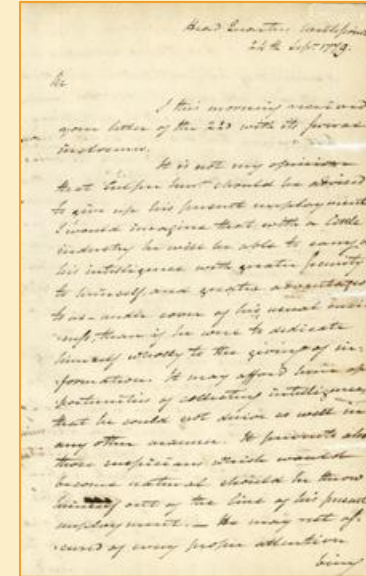

- [ACM Guide to Computing Literature](#) - 1960s-present for ACM titles, dates vary for others. Fulltext for all ACM publications, citations and abstracts for others. Articles, proceedings, books, theses, SIG newsletters.
- [Arts & Humanities Citation Index](#) - 1975-present. Citations & abstracts for nearly 1,130 leading arts and humanities journals. Cited reference searching. Subset of Web of Science.
- [arXiv.org](#) - Date coverage varies. Open access to 465,727 e-prints in Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science, Quantitative Biology and Statistics.
- [BioMedCentral](#)
- [CiteSeer](#) - Date coverage varies. An autonomous citation indexing system which focuses primarily on the literature in computer and information science.
- [Compendex](#) - 1969-present. Citations and abstracts. Most comprehensive coverage of scientific and technical engineering research, covering all engineering disciplines; began as Engineering Index in 1896. Over 5000 international sources, including journals, conference proceedings, book chapters, etc.

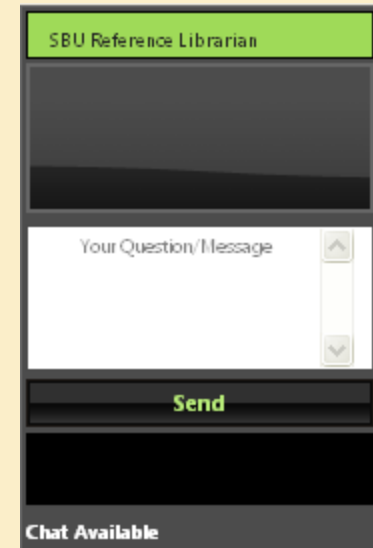
